

If the cable companies' spectrum license transfer applications to Verizon Wireless are approved they should only be done so conditionally on the condition Verizon is required to put the AWS spectrum to use with tough build out requirements not only implemented but enforced.

Considering Verizon Wireless has sufficient AWS spectrum it is underutilizing currently before allowing them to acquire anymore AWS spectrum they should be required to put their existing spectrum holdings though to use. I hereby request that the FCC deny the SpectrumCo and Cox applications and require Verizon Wireless to use their existing AWS licenses. I believe the FCC should have a use it or lose it rule. All companies not using their spectrum should be given advance warning that you need to use it or lose it. If Verizon Wireless refuses to put this existing spectrum to use it should have these spectrum licenses taken away from their company. Also the FCC must adopt AWS Service Rules and 700 MHz Interoperability. Verizon Wireless should also be forbidden from participating then in incentive auctions unless it is going to use the spectrum efficiently and properly.
