This is to inform the Commission that on May 8, 2012, Los Angeles County Sheriff Leroy Baca, Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors Chairman Zev Yaroslavsky, Los Angeles County Chief Executive Officer Bill Fujioka, Los Angeles Regional Interoperable Communications System (LA-RICS) Executive Director Pat Mallon, and other representatives of Los Angeles County met with staff of the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau. The following Commission staff were present: Jennifer Manner, Thomas Beers, Brian Marengo, Roberto Mussenden, Michael Wilhelm, Genaro Fullano, Erika Olsen and John Enright. The principal purpose of the meeting was to discuss the impact of Section 6103 of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 on the 470-512 MHz licenses held by Los Angeles County and other LA-RICS participants. On a separate matter, Mr. Mallon also briefly mentioned that LA-RICS advocates an extension of its 700 MHz broadband waiver and spectrum lease, as is more fully discussed in comments previously filed by LA-RICS in the above-referenced proceeding.
