**SUPPLEMENT TO SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION**

SIGECOM, LLC, d/b/a WOW! Internet, Cable and Phone (“Sigecom”), through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, hereby files this Supplement to provide additional information with respect to the Application filed by Sigecom in the referenced docket.

As fully described in the Application, Sigecom intends to discontinue the service in phases over the next several months. The Application relates to the second phase of the planned service discontinuance. In this second phase, written notice to the group of affected commercial and residential customers was mailed on or about April 25, 2012. The written notice was mailed to 149 commercial customers located in Evansville, Indiana, and to 125 residential customers located in Evansville, Indiana (the “Affected Customers”).

For the reasons set forth fully in the Application, Sigecom believes that the proposed discontinuance is reasonable and necessary. Sigecom will take all reasonable steps, to the extent it is able, to assure that the discontinuance of service is not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, Sigecom respectfully requests that the

Commission permit it to discontinue the provision of services to the Affected Customers pursuant to Section 63.71.


