Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 22, 2012, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless filed its response to the FCC Information and Discovery Request of March 8, 2012 in the above-referenced docket.¹ That response has been updated and supplemented in subsequent filings. By this filing, Verizon Wireless is providing further documents in response to the FCC's Information and Discovery Request including:

- As requested by FCC staff, we are providing additional documents based upon certain revised searches discussed with the staff.² The updated materials address requests referred to in questions 9b-d, 12, 21, 30, 35a-b, and 36 of the FCC's Information and Discovery Request, and have been placed on a disk titled "VZW-006." Exhibit A hereto provides the names and titles of the additional custodians whose documents are

being provided. Exhibit C hereto provides the modified search terms used to identify these documents.

- Also as requested by FCC staff, we are providing additional documents identified as responsive to the FCC's request in question 31. The additional documents have been placed on a disk titled "VZW-007." As discussed with FCC staff, by including such materials and identifying these individuals as custodians in the metadata, Verizon Wireless is not implying or representing that the entirety of their files has been digitized or electronically searched, or that a broader search of their materials has been undertaken in connection with the "all documents" requests. Exhibit B hereto provides the names and titles of the additional custodians whose documents are being provided as responsive to the FCC's request in question 31.
- An overlay updating responsive tagging for documents previously produced as responsive to the FCC's requests that have also been identified as responsive to requests referred to in 9b-d, 12, 21, 30, 35a-b, or 36 by the revised search terms.³
- As discussed with staff, given the subject matter of the requests to which these documents are responsive, and in order to expedite this production, all documents have been temporarily designated "Highly Confidential" under the *Second Protective Order* in this docket.⁴ Verizon Wireless will shortly provide a database overlay that will downgrade that designation from "Highly Confidential" to either "Confidential" (as defined under the *Protective Order* in this docket) or "public," where appropriate, based on a review now underway.
- Two files titled "Priv_Log_20120426_HIGHLY_CONFIDENTIAL.xls" and "Priv_Log_VZW_007_20120426_HIGHLY_CONFIDENTIAL.xls" included on the encrypted hard drive containing the supplemental production providing privilege log data for items flagged by the search terms for the new custodians.


