Ms. Ludovici:

This communication is made pursuant to section 76.61 of the rules of the FCC. It is the opinion of the owners and operators of KAZV TV, licensed to Modesto, CA, that it is a qualified low power station and therefore a “must carry” for Charter Communications head ends located at Turlock, and Livingston, CA. This is based upon the following:

1. The station is the only licensed LOCAL station between Sacramento and Fresno, CA.
2. The station meets the programming requirements of the FCC for all types of programming, including Children’s Programming and non-entertainment programming.
3. The station delivers an OTA signal, of standard quality, and is in the process of upgrading to delivery to the headed by SDI transfer stream. This conversion is expected to be completed by April 15, 2012.
4. KAZV serves communities, including Ceres, Riverbank, Turlock Hughson, Empire, Waterford, Salida and the remainder of Stanislaus County, with programming created in the county and/or of interest to the residents of the county, and the cities and communities therein.
5. Stations located in Sacramento, San Francisco and Fresno do not serve the same needs of the communities within our area in that they provide minimal coverage of local events, limited exposure of local organizations, and limited advertising opportunities within an affordable range to small local businesses.
6. The Public Interest will best be served by continuing to offer KAZV on the basic cable section of the offerings of Charter Communications as evidenced by communications received by your office from members of the served community.

The owners and management of KAZV TV request that Charter Communication continue to carry the signal of KAZV TV, as has been done for several years, on channel 14. In the alternative, KAZV TV requests a discussion of an alternative channel designation for the station.

Finally, KAZV requests that Charter Communications continue to carry the station during the pendency of these negotiations.
