As you may know, KAZV (Charter cable channel 14) is a source of local public information for Turlock and a great portion of Stanislaus County and, as such, is a valuable resource for its residents.

California State University, Stanislaus and other academic institutions in the county regularly air educational programs on KAZV and the removal of this public access channel would be a great loss.

I understand that KAZV's Board of Directors are working on technical upgrades to improve their signal quality and that progress is expected in the near future. I urge you to continue to air KAZV programming the good of our community.
