Dear Ms. Dortch:

By Public Notice issued April 2, 2012, the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") notified various petitioners that had requested an exemption from the FCC's closed captioning rules that each was required to: (i) affirm that its previously filed petition remained accurate and up-to-date; (ii) update the information contained in its previously filed petition; or (iii) withdraw its previously filed petition.¹

One of the petitioners included in the Public Notice was Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. with regard to a petition it had filed for television station KSBI(TV), Facility ID No. 38214. Case Identifier CGB-CC-0347.

Family Broadcasting Group, Inc., by its attorneys, hereby withdraws the petition in question. As a video programming provider that produced less than \$3,000,000 in annual gross revenue during the previous calendar year, KSBI(TV) is not required to expend any money to caption its programming.²
