

Dear Mr. Turetsky:

Flat Wireless, LLC ("Flat") joined with several other carriers on April 5, 2012 to request a short term waiver of the deadline for implementation of the Commission's Commercial Mobile Alert System. The waiver was necessitated by systemic problems between the petitioners' CMAS vendor and FEMA. Flat had hoped and expected that the CMAS system would be online no later than May 15, 2012.

This letter will confirm that the CMAS network administered by Telecommunications Systems in which Flat participates has now been able to achieve operational interconnection with the FEMA gateway. The resolution of the issue which prompted the waiver petition now permits emergency alerts to be distributed to handsets capable of receiving such alerts, and the need for a waiver going forward has therefore been obviated.
