REQUEST TO WITHDRAW

On April 28, 2006, Hand Held Products, Inc. (“HHP”) requested a ruling that the hearing aid compatibility (“HAC”) obligations in Part 20 of the Commission’s rules do not apply to HHP’s mobile computing devices (the “HHP Request”).¹ On August 5, 2010, the Commission adopted a Second Report and Order revising its HAC rules.²

The *Second Report and Order* confirmed that the HAC rules did not in fact apply to HHP’s mobile computing devices when it stated, “[i]f handsets are not offered to service providers, then the benchmarks in Section 20.19 do not apply.”³ The *Second Report and Order* adopted new HAC obligations on a prospective basis. Commission staff has requested that HHP formally withdraw the HHP Request as it is now moot in light of the *Second Report and Order*.

Honeywell International, Inc., which acquired HHP in December 2007, filed a Supplement to the request on February 12, 2008 and a Further Supplement on March 17, 2008. The Commission has not taken formal action on the HHP Request.
