Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 25, 2012, Steven Berry and Rebecca Thompson of RCA — The Competitive Carriers Association (“RCA”) and the undersigned met with Commissioner Ajit Pai and his Chief of Staff, Matthew Berry, and Acting Legal Advisor, Gene Fullano, to discuss RCA’s mission and priorities. RCA described its support for policies that will promote increased wireless competition and deliver benefits to consumers, including in rural areas. RCA in particular pointed out the critical need to ensure (a) interoperability in the Lower 700 MHz band, (b) the availability of data roaming on commercially reasonable terms, and (c) more technologically and competitive neutral universal service support mechanisms. RCA expressed its interest in exploring market-based solutions wherever possible to address these and other vital public policy objectives, while noting that Commission involvement is necessary at this stage to avoid the need for more intrusive regulatory intervention down the road.
