

Unjust and unnecessary blocking of wireless services to censor or stifle freedom of expression or free speech whether it is conducted by an agency in the federal government like the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), National Security Agency (NSA), Federal Communications Commission (FCC), state regulatory agencies with oversight of public utilities including communications companies or agencies like San Francisco's Bay Area Rapid Transit which manages San Francisco's subway system is unacceptable. Furthermore, unnecessary and unconstitutional intrusions and invasions of privacy by such agencies are also unacceptable. Any time any agency wants information on an individual or group of individual's electronic communications they should be required to get a search warrant.

I urge the FCC to collaborate with the DOJ and FBI with some input from consumer groups and privacy watchdog groups on creating and maintaining lists of best practices for when if wireless service interruptions are acceptable determining if they are acceptable and in what circumstances (should be rare and be proven that there was a threat to wireless system so it needed to be shutdown i.e. legitimate cyber security threat) and similarly best practices for requesting information from communications providers on user's data.
