**Re: Notice of Inadvertent Forwarding of Confidential Ex Parte Filed By
General Communicaton, Inc. in WC Docket No. 10-90 and WT Docket No.
10-208**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Protective Order in the above-referenced dockets, I am writing to inform the Commission that on June 12, 2012, I inadvertently forwarded an email containing a confidential version of the ex parte filed by General Communication, Inc. ("GCI") on July 11, 2012, to Jessica Zufolo and Nita Contreras at RUS, with "cc" copies to Larry Mayes and Andilea Weaver of Adak Eagle Enterprises, LLC ("AEE").

Upon realizing this mistake, I immediately took the following steps to ensure that the email containing the ex parte was retracted and deleted by all recipients before any improper review or disclosure of confidential information:

- 1) Within one minute, I recalled the email containing the GCI ex parte;
- 2) I sent an email to Ms. Zufolo, Ms. Contreras, Mr. Mayes, and Ms. Weaver, asking them to immediately delete the email containing the ex parte;
- 3) I individually called each of the email recipients to inform them that I had recalled the email containing the ex parte and asked them to delete the email without reviewing its contents; and
- 4) I asked each recipient of the email to provide written confirmation that they had deleted the email without reviewing its contents.

After taking these steps, I received additional written confirmation from Ms. Weaver that the email containing the ex parte had been permanently deleted from AEE's computer system.

without review, and I received written confirmation from Ms. Contreras that, due to the recall of the email, she was unable to open it and had deleted it.

Finally, I immediately contacted John Nakahata, counsel to GCI, to inform him of the inadvertent forwarding of the ex parte and the immediate steps taken to remedy the mistake.
