(Certification of Rural and Non-Rural High Cost Support for Pa Makani LLC, dba Sandwich Isles Wireless Pursuant to Title 47, Sections 54.313 and 54.314, WC Docket No. 10-90)

Dear Ms. Dortch and Ms. Majcher:

The Commission respectfully files this letter pursuant to Title 47, Sections 54.313 and 54.314 of the Code of Federal Regulations ("C.F.R.").

On April 10, 2012, the Commission designated Pa Makani LLC, dba Sandwich Isles Wireless ("Pa Makani") as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") within the State of Hawaii, subject to certain conditions.¹

Consistent with federal law and the Commission's Decision and Order No. 30309, filed on April 10, 2012, in Docket No. 2011-0145, Pa Makani: (1) is eligible to receive federal universal service support; and (2) intends to use such support only "for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended." 47 United States Code § 254(e); and 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313 and 54.314. This initial (or supplemental) certification applies to federal universal service high-cost support through the end of the current program year, from April 10, 2012, to December 31, 2012, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313 and 54.314.

If this letter does not fully satisfy the requirements for state certification of carriers to receive federal universal service support, the Commission requests a waiver of the June 9, 2012 deadline to correct any deficiencies.
