


Securus Technologies

SCP Centralized System Path of an Inmate Call



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Service provider is certificated carrier holding public contract after bid <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • States require certificate as OSP, LD reseller, or LEC 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> X Call diverter registers as "interconnected VoIP" (if at all) and does not hold public contract <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Call diversion cannot satisfy VoIP definition in 47 C.F.R. § 9.3
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Service provider must block calls to protected persons and to persons whom inmates are prohibited from calling 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> X Call diverters enable inmates to complete calls to prohibited numbers
