**ORDER**

In Section I, paragraph 2, of *Order* (FCC 12M-26), released May 23, 2012, Maritime and the Enforcement Bureau were instructed to file *Stipulations* on the operational status of Maritime's licensed stations, the dates of construction and commencement of operations. In addition, the parties were to submit new hearing and procedural dates in the same *Stipulation*. The *Stipulations* were to be filed by **May 31, 2012**.

On May 31<sup>st</sup> Maritime made no filing, while the Enforcement Bureau filed two pleadings: (1) Limited Joint Stipulation Between Enforcement Bureau and Maritime and Proposed Scheduled; and (2) Enforcement Bureau's Status Report on Joint Stipulation with Maritime. No responsive or explanatory papers or pleading(s) have been received from Maritime.

A review of Enforcement Bureau's pleadings reflects that it contains no signature by Maritime. While the pleading is styled "Joint Limited Stipulation", it is signed only by the Bureau. However, that Joint Limited Stipulation, in fully executed form, is required for the Presiding Judge to consider the most efficient way to advance this case.

Of course, a Maritime signature on the document would readily suffice to cure this incomplete document. It would certainly foster Maritime's reputation for corporation which has appeared somewhat elusive of late.

Otherwise, Maritime must file a full explanation giving reason(s) for refusing or failing to sign the Joint Stipulation, to be filed by Friday Noon, **June 8, 2012**.
