On March 2, 2012 Bandwidth.com, Inc. (“Bandwidth”) filed an ex parte notice documenting its meetings of February 29, 2012 and the presentation materials used during its meetings. # Budgetary Pricing Assumptions

- Clearinghouse Functions only
  - Single (redundant) points of delivery for service providers
  - Location acquired from carriers, destination derived, and location stored for query
  - Handoff to state-level delivery point for selected delivery method/vendor
- Procurement by the FCC (direct or through an LLC)
  - Budgetary pricing does not include contract acquisition costs or cost of compliance and reporting if the FCC is the contracting organization
  - Procurement by wireless carriers may raise price per carrier and in the aggregate
- Support for 50 state-selected vendors/methods of delivery
  - Native NG9-1-1 (preferred)
  - Text to SMS Relay
  - Text to TTY
  - Text to Server (browser access by PSAP)
- Support for deaf and hard of hearing community
  - Solution will scale and support for all wireless subscribers should have minimal impact on costs
- Support for most commonly used interfaces and transport protocols

# Budgetary Pricing

- Non-recurring setup costs: \$600,000
- 3 year monthly recurring costs between \$3.9 mil and \$11.4 mil
- Total 3 year budgetary price between \$4.5 mil and \$12.0 mil

*Note: price range reflects several options for subscriber location information acquisition*

# Planning Implementation Timeline

- **Phase 1:** Text to SMS Relay available within 120 days of project initiation
- **Phase 2:** Text to TTY available to all states with existing network connectivity selecting this option within 180 days of project initiation
- **Phase 3:** Text to Server available to all states selecting this option within 240 days of project initiation
- **Phase 4:** Text to NG9-1-1 available to all States, counties, or PSAPs selecting this option within 270 days of project initiation

*Note: Some overlap in phases is possible and desirable. i.e. Support for NG9-1-1 can be available as 9-1-1 Authorities implement*
