

Verizon and AT&T are already monopolies don't let them accumulate more spectrum for warehousing. Deny the Verizon Cable deals or put strong conditions on them affecting both their ability to implement the JOE expressly forbidding the JOE to prevent the broadband duopoly from becoming a far worse cable monopoly (there was a time in the 1990s the government was committed to protecting broadband competition and competition in the computer operating systems software and web browser market. There is some evidence Microsoft is back to its old tricks by denying third party web browsers from running on Windows RT – its new mobile operating system for ARM devices from running within the Metro environment at all.
