On June 26, 2012, Kevin Krufky, Vice President, Public Affairs, Americas Region and the undersigned, of Alcatel-Lucent, met with Charles Mathias, Special Counsel in the Office of Chairman Julius Genachowski. In the meeting, the representatives from Alcatel-Lucent asserted that the Commission has ample authority to place appropriate conditions on all early deployments to ensure interoperability and integration into the forthcoming nationwide public safety broadband network. Messrs. Krufky and Marks also urged that Commission authorizations for early deployments should provide a level of certainty that the Commission, the National Telecommunications and Information Administration and the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) will work to ensure a seamless transition from early deployment to FirstNet.
