

Pursuant to the requirements of 47 C.F.R. §54.313 as clarified by the Federal Communications Commission (the “Commissions”) (*see In the Matter of Connect America Fund, et al., Order*, WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., DA 12-147, released February 3, 2012, ; *Public Notice*, DA 12-729, issued May 8, 2012 (the “*May 8th Public Notice*”); and *In the Matter of Connect America Fund, et al., Order*, WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 12-52, released May 14, 2012), Armstrong Telephone Company – Pennsylvania (the “Company”), an incumbent local exchange carrier operating in the rural areas of Pennsylvania, hereby provides the following information. Should requests for additional information be made by the Commission, the Company is willing to work with the Commission to address such requests.

The Company has previously filed in WC Docket No. 10-90 additional information related to this filing on or about March 28, 2012. That filing consisted of information responsive to Section 54.313(a)(2) through Section 54.313(a)(6). The instant filing supplements that information with respect to Section 54.313(h). With the submission of this supplement and the previously filed information, the Company respectfully submits that the directives noted in the *May 8th Public Notice* have been met.

54.313(h) Information

Additional voice rate data. (1) All incumbent local exchange carrier recipients of high-cost support must report all of their rates for residential local service for all portions of their service area, as well as state fees as defined pursuant to § 54.318(e) of this subpart, to the extent the sum of those rates and fees are below the rate floor as defined in § 54.318 of this subpart, and the number of lines for each rate specified. Carriers shall report lines and rates in effect as of June 1. (2) In addition to the annual filing, local exchange carriers may file updates of their rates for residential local service, as well as state fees as defined pursuant to § 54.318(e) of this subpart, on January 2 of each year. If a local exchange carrier reduces its rates and the sum of the reduced rates and state fees are below the rate floor as defined in §54.318 of this subpart, the local exchange carrier shall file such an update. For the update, carriers shall report lines and rates in effect as of December 1. (47 C.F.R. §54.313 (h))

The Company’s applicable rates for residential local service are above the local urban rate floor of \$10 as provided for in Section 54.318 of the Commission’s rules.
