Ability to reroute traffic around damaged facilities:

Table Top Telephone Company, Inc. has built a collapsed SONET fiber link from the Ajo Central Office to connecting company's Central Office in Gila Bend. Ajo has a microwave link for diverse path on some DS1 circuits to the connecting company. Aguila, Bagdad, and Seligman utilize existing microwave links to connect to the connecting company to get to the toll tandem. TTT has built a collapsed SONET fiber link between its Aguila and Bagdad Central Offices. TTT proposes to begin construction in 2012 of a collapsed SONET fiber link between the Bagdad, Talking Rock, and Seligman Central Offices. The Sanders and Talking Rock Central Offices have collapsed SONET fiber links to the connecting company.
