






**Certification of Officer as to Compliance with  
47 CFR § 54.313(a)(6) and §54.202(a)(2)**

Pursuant to the annual reporting requirements for high-cost recipients set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 54.313(a)(6), any recipient of high-cost support shall provide a certification that the carrier is able to function in emergency situations as set forth in § 54.202(a)(2).

Section 54.202(a)(2) requires that a designated eligible telecommunications carrier “[d]emonstrate its ability to remain functional in emergency situations, including a demonstration that it has a reasonable amount of back-up power to ensure functionality without an external power source, is able to reroute traffic around damaged facilities, and is capable of managing traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations.”

Based on the aforementioned, I, Mario Barrera Orozco in my capacity of Chief Operations Officer for Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. (“PRTC”), certify that my responsibilities include ensuring compliance with the requirements of 47 CFR 54.202(a)(2) that the carrier is able to function in emergency situations.
