Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform you that, on July 2, 2012, Stacy Fuller of DIRECTV, LLC and undersigned counsel met with Michelle Carey, Mary Beth Murphy, Alison Neplokh, and Diana Sokolow of the Commission's Media Bureau with respect to the Petitions for Temporary Partial Exemption or Limited Waiver filed by the Digital Media Association in the above referenced proceeding. In particular, they discussed DIRECTV's ongoing efforts in cooperation with third-party hardware and software companies to develop the capabilities necessary to comply with the "rendering" requirements for closed captioning of video delivered via Internet protocol recently adopted by the Commission. They also outlined the challenges faced in achieving compliance with respect to some platforms by the September 30, 2012 implementation deadline, especially given that not all platforms will accept captioning information delivered using the safe-harbor SMPTE-TT protocol.
