On July 2, 2012, Antoinette Cook Bush, Tara S. Emory, and the undersigned of this firm, Outside Counsel to Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint”), conducted a telephone conference with Louis Peraertz, legal advisor to Commissioner Clyburn.

In this call, the Sprint representatives discussed backhaul provided to wireless carriers and the issues potentially impacting Cable Company WiFi users who are customers of mobile service providers other than Verizon Wireless, which had been discussed in our meeting of June 15.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Peraertz asked several questions related to the use of WiFi by commercial mobile service subscribers. The Sprint representatives agreed to provide answers from Sprint as soon as possible.
