Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Americus Communications, LLC, ('Americus') Licensee of Stations WPCN (AM) and WSPT (FM), Stevens Point, WI and on behalf of RLM Communications, Inc., ('RLM') Licensee of WKQH (FM), Marathon, WI, (the two companies are commonly owned and operate the above-referenced stations from a single studio) this is to request a temporary waiver of the EAS requirement requiring upgrade of EAS equipment to include Common Alerting Protocol (CAP) capability by June 30, 2012. A waiver of 3 months is requested, until September 30, 2012.

The equipment necessary to comply with the new regulation is expensive to obtain; Americus and RLM are independent but commonly-owned Licensees operating in a small market in a tight and unforgiving economy. Since the deadline for implementation of CAP protocol equipment has been extended twice, Americus and RLM waited to make the necessary expenditure to see if the deadline might be extended again. Since it has not, Americus and RLM ordered and paid in advance for the necessary equipment, but apparently because of a recent rush in orders, that equipment is on backorder, and will not be shipped until August. (see attached email purchase order confirmation).

The order was placed in the normal course, and normally would have been shipped and installed in time for the June 30, 2012 deadline. The shipment delay is not within the Licensees' control. Accordingly, Americus and RLM request a temporary waiver of the rule to permit the above-referenced Stations to operate without the compliant equipment for 3 additional months. The Stations will continue to operate with its legacy EAS equipment and procedures until the new equipment is installed.


