On Thursday, July 12, 2012, Lance Steinhart, Brita Strandberg, and Heather Kirby, on behalf of You Talk Mobile, LLC (“You Talk” or the “Company”), as well as Stephen Klein, President of You Talk, spoke with Kimberly Scardino, Divya Shenoy, and Alexander Minard of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division. We discussed You Talk’s Compliance Plan as filed on April 27, 2012.

Stephen Klein gave an overview of the Company and his experience in the telecommunications industry. Mr. Klein emphasized the Company’s commitment to comply with all FCC rules and to prevent waste, fraud, and abuse of the Lifeline program. We discussed You Talk’s enrollment process and procedures regarding fraud prevention, noting how the Company highlights the One Per Household certification at the beginning of the enrollment process. We also discussed updates the Company has made to its Lifeline certification form. Finally, You Talk agreed to file a revised Compliance Plan incorporating suggested edits.
