



| Type of Change | This project will redirect end users from the North Wire Center to the Mt. View CEV. |
| Scope of Work | Existing Alaska Communications services in this area originate from North Wire Center. Current loops are too long to provide high speed services without extensive man hours to design and build the necessary facilities. This project will redirect the existing End Users in this area to the Mt. View CEV. By this incorporation, the longest loop will be in approximately the 5,000'-7,000' range, which allows Alaska Communications to provide high speed services. Presently, the longest loop for this area is approximately 20,000 feet. |
| Impact | Presently, there are approximately 165 subscriber lines that will be affected by this project. Upon completion, this project will shorten the digital loop to the subscriber, resulting in greater reliability, service quality, and allow for the offering of additional services. |
| Downtime | This project will result in downtime of approximately 5 minutes per subscriber. |

| Cut Date | Transfer work to begin at or near August 31, 2012. |
