I, Ralph Newcomb, hereby declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am Vice President of Technical Operations for Time Warner Cable Inc. ("Time Warner Cable"), the owner and manager of the cable system involved in the foregoing Petition for Special Relief ("Petition"); and
2. In my position, I manage a staff of expert technicians responsible for the operation, construction and maintenance of Time Warner Cable's cable system. I am routinely in the field with my employees observing their activities, as well as the activities of other utility's construction, maintenance and operational employees, in the Wisconsin communities of the Village of Elmwood Park, the City of Kenosha, the Village of Mt.
