
Re: *Special Access for Price Cap Local Exchange Carriers, WC Docket No. 05-25*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 18, 2012, Christopher Wright, of Wiltshire & Grannis LLP, and I met with Priscilla Delgado Argeris and Paul Murray, Legal Advisors to Commissioner Rosenworcel, regarding the above-captioned proceeding. We discussed the topics covered in the letter that Sprint filed in this docket on May 23, 2012.¹ Specifically, we discussed the need for the FCC to discontinue use of the broken special access pricing flexibility triggers, the need to quickly issue the pending mandatory data request, anticompetitive terms and conditions, and that DS-1 and DS-3 services remain vital to the national economy.
