On July 19, 2012, Jeffrey Carlisle, Executive Vice President – Regulatory Affairs and Public Policy of LightSquared, Jeffrey L. Turner of Patton Boggs LLP, and the undersigned of Latham & Watkins LLP, met with Courtney Reinhard of Commissioner Ajit Pai’s office. The discussion focused upon (i) the significant public interest benefits that would flow from the deployment of LightSquared’s authorized 4G LTE network, including how its wholesale business model would both significantly enhance competition in the wireless industry and facilitate the development of innovative wireless applications, (ii) the compelling need to find spectrum-based, technical, legal, or other solutions to the current issues involving LightSquared, and (iii) the LightSquared proposals that are detailed in (x) its May 17 Notice of Ex Parte Presentation in the L Band Proceedings (pages 4-6), and (y) its April 25, 2012 letter (pages 3-4), May 17, 2012 comments (pages 4-8), and June 1, 2012 reply in the 2 GHz Proceedings (pages 5-6).
