Dear Mr. Turetsky:

On Wednesday, April 4, 2012, Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile, through its attorneys, notified the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) that due to delays of a third party vendor, Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile was unable to launch CMAS on a timely basis and therefore it [requested/required] an extension from the FCC. Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile is also a member of the Rural Telecommunications Group, Inc. (“RTG”). On Friday, April, 6, 2012, RTG filed a waiver request on behalf of its carrier members. On Tuesday, May 22, 2012, Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile filed with the FCC a second, independent waiver request.

With this letter, Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile is pleased to inform the Commission that its CMAS vendor, Intrado, Inc., has achieved connectivity to the Federal Emergency Management Gateway and that Wisconsin RSA #7 Limited Partnership DBA Element Mobile’s subscribers are now able to receive wireless emergency alerts on CMAS-capable devices in accordance with the Commission’s rules governing the CMAS program.
