Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Townsquare Media Oneonta License, LLC, the licensee of the broadcast stations listed above (the "Stations"), this is to request a temporary waiver, pursuant to Section 11.52(d)(4) of the Commission's rules, of the Common Alerting Protocol ("CAP") Emergency Alert System requirements set forth in Part 11 of the Commission's rules.

Townsquare timely installed CAP-compliant equipment for all the Stations, and that equipment is functioning properly. However, the Stations' common main studio is in Walton, NY, and no commercial broadband Internet service is available there. The Stations currently are using a dial-up Internet connection for delivery of CAP messages. This connection has enabled the Stations to receive CAP-formatted messages in some, but not all, instances.

To remedy this problem, Townsquare is in the process of installing a private microwave system to connect the Stations' Walton main studio location to a nearby Townsquare main studio location, which would give the Stations access to broadband Internet service. Townsquare estimates that this can be completed within three to six months.

In the interim, Townsquare respectfully requests a temporary waiver of the obligations set forth in Part 11 of the Commission's rules regarding monitoring, receiving and processing CAP-formatted messages for the Stations. The Stations continue to receive legacy EAS alerts without issue. Townsquare will promptly notify the Commission as soon as the Stations are able to obtain broadband Internet access as described above.


DECLARATION OF DAVID J. REMUND
