

The FCC should as part of AWS Service Rules implement open access conditions on wireless service providers using AWS spectrum just as they did for 700 MHz spectrum holders and ensure those open access conditions are properly enforced upon both carriers with 700 MHz spectrum licenses and AWS licenses requiring their wireless networks comply with Network Neutrality provisions of nondiscrimination and open access. Also interoperability rules are a must.

It's been reported by Free Press that Verizon Wireless has repeatedly violated open access conditions imposed on its use of 700 MHz spectrum (they now want to sell some 700 MHz spectrum) and they have to be held accountable for that as their deal with SpectrumCo and Cox is reviewed. The JOE needs to be denied at the very least even if the license transfer is granted.
