On July 20, 2012, Jim Wilson, Patrick Cook and Riki Kline of Wilson Electronics, Inc. ("Wilson") and Sean Haynberg of V-COMM, L.C.C. ("V-COMM") spoke via telephone with Joyce Jones and Moslem Sawez of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau about the consumer signal booster safe harbor that was jointly proposed in the above-referenced proceeding by Wilson, V-COMM, Verizon Wireless, T-Mobile, USA, Inc., and Nextivity, Inc.

The parties discussed the concerns expressed by Wireless Extenders, Inc. ("Wi-Ex") with respect to the safe harbor's limits on mobile station coupling loss and out-of-band emissions. Messrs. Wilson and Haynberg agreed to contact Wi-Ex to address its concerns.

The parties also discussed how far a signal booster's range would extend outside a standard passenger vehicle utilizing the maximum gain before AGC reduction.
