
On May 25, 2012, Smith Media License Holdings, LLC ("Smith"), filed a Complaint for retransmission without Smith's consent of the signal of WFFF-TV, Burlington, Vermont, against Trans-video Cable ("Trans-video") with respect to Trans-video's cable systems serving Northfield, Vermont.

The parties have reached an agreement retroactive to and effective as of January 1, 2012. As a result, Trans-video has been retransmitting the signal of WFFF-TV with Smith's consent throughout the current retransmission consent carriage cycle, rendering the Complaint moot. Accordingly, Smith hereby withdraws the Complaint and requests that the Commission close this proceeding without taking any further action.
