To Whom It May Concern:

The Indiana Rural Health Association, as lead entity for the Indiana Telehealth Network, received a Funding Commitment Letter (FCL) for Smithville Digital LLC on January 12, 2012, with a Funding Request Number (FRN) of 57881.

This FCL includes funding for the following healthcare participating sites:

Construction for these sites was initiated during the first quarter of 2012. As of July 30, 2012, construction has not yet been completed at any of these locations. Smithville Digital has experienced significant construction delays related to railroad crossings and utility pole permitting.

At this time, Smithville has not invoiced any of the HCPs for any portion of construction. Therefore, the ITN has not yet filed a Form 467 for FRN 57881. As soon as we receive notice from Smithville that they are ready to invoice the HCPs listed above, we will file the associated Form 467 with USAC.
