Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter supplements the information contained in the above-referenced applications with respect to the ownership of T-Mobile License LLC.^{1/}

As explained in the public interest statement accompanying these applications,^{2/} and as noted in our most recent ownership report,^{3/} T-Mobile License LLC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile USA”) which, in turn, is a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of Deutsche Telekom AG (“DT”), a publicly-traded German corporation. The FCC recently approved DT’s foreign investment in connection with the transfer of control of Cook Inlet GSM IV PCS Holdings, LLC to T-Mobile USA.^{4/} Since that time, no changes inconsistent with the authority granted by the Commission have taken place with respect to T-Mobile USA’s foreign ownership.
