

Pay TV providers like the big cable companies are facing increased competition from Google Fiber which will include broadband Internet of 1GBPs (1 gigabits per second) and its own pay TV service for less than the cable monopolies charge and then there is the competition from the online video market and from services like Google TV, Apple TV, Roku, Netflix (Watch Now) for streaming that companies like Comcast which is selling Verizon spectrum are trying to interfere with by using discriminatory data caps.
