Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 8, 2012, representatives of broadband providers, public interest groups, companies, and other organizations met with Commission staff to discuss the Commission's 2012 broadband measurement and performance program in the ng Measurement Architecture Standardization and Outreach Group. The meeting focused on discussion of input on draft documents circulated to the group and a draft of high level goals and requirements that would provide background for providing comments and drafts in advance of upcoming deadlines for contributions to standards bodies. A full list of meeting attendees and the draft goals and requirements document is attached to this filing.

Mr. Walter Johnston, Chief Electromagnetic Compatibility Division (EMCD), opened the meeting stating the efforts of the group were proceeding and near term work would focus on contributions and support of standards activities in Fall 2012. James Miller, Senior Attorney Advisor EMCD, reviewed the past documents circulated to the group and Mr. Johnston presented a draft of high-level goals and requirements requested by participants to aid in drafting and commentary on the other circulated documents. Mr. Johnston explained that editing of the specific language in the circulated documents wasn't necessary. Mr. Miller explained that the circulated documents were intended to outline the major issues, and asked that input adding or expanding on elements focus on ensuring that all issues and major concerns were identified in the drafts.

Mr. Henning Schulzrinne, FCC Chief Technologist, described the process for IETF submission and interaction on on performance metrics and reported that initial work on a mailing list was complete but an Internet draft should be prepared in advance of September 24 for circulation in the IETF group.

Michael Bugenhagen and Ken Ko discussed ongoing work of the Broadband Forum and noted the had proceeded past the new project stage and had circulated its first document with the IETF standards group describing the framework for the groups proposed work. They noted that a document identifying the FCC's Goals and Scope should be circulated to the Forum by August 27 for consideration by that group. The group agreed that contributions to drafting would be done via email and circulated back to the group at a future meeting.

The meeting concluded with a general agreement to continue with discussions with both the IETF and the Broadband Forum and contribute to the work discussed.
