PARTIES' JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the order of the Chief Administrative Law Judge dated August 8, 2012, Game Show Network, LLC (“GSN”) and Cablevision Systems Corp. (“Cablevision”) (collectively, the “parties”) submit the following joint status report in the above-captioned action.

The parties have exchanged requests for documents and objections thereto. The parties subsequently have held several meet-and-confer sessions to address each party’s respective objections. The parties currently have resolved the majority of their respective objections, and they will continue efforts to work out their remaining issues. The parties have begun to produce documents on a rolling basis. The parties appreciate the Chief Administrative Law Judge’s attention to this matter, and will continue to cooperate to ensure that discovery stays the course in this expedited proceeding.

To date, the parties have identified three discovery issues as to which they have not yet reached agreement, though they expect to continue to work to resolve these issues:

- (1) the number of fact depositions to which each party is entitled;

(2) the inclusion of James Dolan, Cablevision's CEO, as a custodian whose files will be searched for responsive documents. Cablevision has thus far refused to include Mr. Dolan as a custodian for its searches, and GSN believes that his documents should be searched; and

(3) the appropriate sampling of hours and types of GSN programming that GSN will produce to Cablevision. GSN objected to Cablevision's initial request on burden grounds and is considering a revised request.

The parties will continue to meet-and-confer on these issues, and any other discovery matters that arise, and will seek the Presiding Judge's assistance, in the event that it is needed. If there are discovery issues that cannot be resolved through negotiation, the parties will, in the interest of efficiency, endeavor to present together all outstanding issues to the Presiding Judge for joint consideration and resolution unless the Presiding Judge prefers the parties present such issues earlier as they arise.
