NOTICE OF ORAL EX PARTE PRESENTATION

Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules to notify the Commission that on August 16, 2012, Mark Uncapher of the Telecommunications Industry Association ("TIA"), Jeffrey Campbell and Mary Brown of Cisco Systems, Inc., Peter Pitsch and Marjorie Dickman of Intel Corporation, and the undersigned met on behalf of TIA with Commissioner Ajit V. Pai and his Legal Advisor, Courtney Reinhard, to discuss TIA's perspective on, among other things, certain spectrum-related issues before the Commission in the above-referenced proceedings.

During the course of the meeting, we reiterated TIA's support for the use of incentive auctions no later than June 2014 to free broadcast spectrum for licensed wireless broadband use, and discussed how the Commission could structure its rules to maximize the amount of spectrum made available to licensed services. TIA also recommended that when the Commission issues a notice of proposed rulemaking regarding the 3550-3650 MHz band later this year, it solicit comment on all possible options for the band and remain open to alternatives other than small cells. We also reported on TIA's assessment of the effort by the National Telecommunications & Information Administration to make the 1755-1780 MHz band available for commercial broadband operations. Finally, we expressed TIA's support for Commission Pai's call for rapid completion of pending Commission rulemakings regarding AWS-4 and the 2.3 GHz Wireless Communications Service band.
