Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 23, 2012, Vonage Holdings Corp's ("Vonage") Brendan Kasper, Senior Regulatory Counsel, and the undersigned counsel met with David Goldman, Senior Legal Advisor, and Holly Saurer, Legal Advisor, to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel.

Vonage discussed issues consistent with its previously filed comments in the above-referenced proceedings regarding the Commission's net neutrality order, the importance of prohibiting discrimination by network operators who have the incentive and capability to engage in anticompetitive practices, especially in light of recent changes in the wireless and wireline broadband industry, and proposed remedies.

In addition, Vonage discussed the United States Department of Justice's Proposed Final Judgment and Competitive Impact Statement filed on August 16, 2012, with the United States District Court for the District of Columbia regarding the Verizon Wireless/SpectrumCo agreements and transactions and the need for the Commission to address the competitive concerns identified above that were not resolved by the Department of Justice's action.
