

The USF fund needs to remain fair for consumers and not keep subsidizing the pockets of big telecom and cable companies at our expense. Before the FCC changes Universal Service Contribution system they need to investigate the corporate subsidies. The FCC's Line Charges enacted over the last decade when the Universal Service Fund was responsible for funding basic telephone service should not be applied to broadband. In fact the FCC Line Charge should be abolished and with it any charges on VOIP service that have been supported by fake so called consumer grassroots organizations like Keep USF Fair Coalition that actually serve the corporate interests of big telecom companies.
