
On August 28, 2012, Doug Smith, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of LightSquared, Jeffrey Carlisle, Executive Vice President – Regulatory Affairs and Public Policy of LightSquared, and Kevin J. Martin and Jeffrey L. Turner of Patton Boggs LLP, met with Commissioner Ajit Pai and his Legal Advisor Courtney Reinhard. The discussion focused upon (i) the significant public interest benefits that would flow from the deployment of LightSquared’s authorized 4G LTE network, including how its wholesale business model would both significantly enhance competition in the wireless industry and facilitate the development of innovative wireless applications, (ii) the compelling need to find spectrum-based, technical, legal, or other solutions to the current issues involving LightSquared, and (iii) the LightSquared proposals that are detailed in (x) its May 17, 2012 Notice of Ex Parte Presentation in the L Band Proceedings (pages 4-6), and (y) its April 25, 2012 letter (pages 3-4), May 17, 2012 comments (pages 4-8), and June 1, 2012 reply in the 2 GHz Proceedings (pages 5-6).

The LightSquared Representatives also stressed the Company’s continuing desire and intention to deploy a nationwide 4G wireless broadband network, and reiterated LightSquared’s view that the Commission has a number of legal and policy responses that it can take to address the inability of a limited number of GPS receivers to operate properly in spectrum that has not been allocated for GPS use, including working with LightSquared and NTIA to develop spectrum solutions to enable LightSquared to deploy its network.
