On August 31, 2012, Alexander Maltas and I, representing Time Warner Cable Inc. ("TWC"), spoke by telephone with David Konczal of the Media Bureau, Policy Division and Jonathan Levy and Anne Levine of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. In response to staff questions, we clarified that the data TWC previously provided regarding premises passed represents the estimated number of video service-ready single residence homes, apartment and condominium units, and commercial establishments passed by TWC's cable systems without further extending the transmission lines. We also explained that, as a general matter, TWC arrives at its estimate of premises passed based on billing records and other data sources. Finally, we clarified that the SportsNet New York regional sports network is satellite-delivered.
