WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION

On June 14, 2012, Windstream Lakedale, Inc. (“Windstream Lakedale”) filed a petition for temporary waiver of Part 11 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. Part 11, regarding monitoring for, receiving, and processing Common Alerting Protocol (“CAP”) formatted messages (the “CAP Rules”) with respect to its video operations, subsequently designed with File No. 201204-296-025.

Windstream Lakedale has since received the equipment necessary to comply with the CAP rules, which it has installed and made operational. Because Windstream Lakedale no longer requires a temporary waiver of the CAP Rules, Windstream Lakedale respectfully withdraws its request.
