**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.46(c), petitioners GCB Communications, Inc. and Lake Country Communications, Inc. (collectively, “GCB”), commenters American Public Communications Council (“APCC”) and APCC Services, Inc., and respondent U.S. South Communications, Inc. (“U.S. South”), by their attorneys, jointly request an extension of time through and including September 24, 2012 for submission of replies in support of U.S. South’s Application for Review (“AFR”) in the captioned proceeding.

The reasons for this request are three-fold. Counsel for U.S. South will be out of town for a mandatory meeting of his law firm partnership from Sept. 7 through Sept. 10, 2012, the day a reply is otherwise due. Second, the Joint Comments in Opposition filed by GCB and APCC on Aug. 31, 2012 overlapped the Labor Day holiday weekend, significantly limiting the time for counsel to assess, confer with U.S. South and prepare a reply submission. Third, and most significantly the parties are simultaneously briefing related matters in connection with a motion for judgment before the district court (U.S. District Court for the District of Arizona), and have agreed to, and moved for, a parallel extension of time for GCB’s reply brief in that civil action.

Counsel for GCB, APCC and U.S. South therefore jointly submit that good cause exists for the requested extension such that this Motion should be granted and the deadline for replies

in connection with the AFR in this proceeding rescheduled for Sept. 24, 2012.
