On behalf of the Electric Plant Board of the City of Glasgow, Kentucky (a/k/a Glasgow EPB), a small municipally-owned cable system (FRN # 0001778893), serving Glasgow and Barren County, Kentucky, I William J. Ray, P.E., Superintendent and CEO, hereby request a streamlined financial hardship waiver of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation ("CALM") Act rules for one year.

Pursuant to the Commissions' December 13, 2011, *Report and Order* in the above-captioned proceeding, I certify that Glasgow EPB: (1) has less than 15,000 subscribers and therefore meets the Commission's definition of a small MVPD system; and (2) needs a delay of one year to avoid the financial hardship that would otherwise be imposed if it were required to purchase the necessary audio monitoring equipment to comply with the requirements of the subject Act.

I represent and warrant that the above certification is consistent with 47 C.F.R. § 1.17 which requires truthful and accurate statements to the Commission. I also acknowledge that false statements and misrepresentations to the Commission are punishable under Title 18 of the U. S. Code and may subject Glasgow EPB to enforcement action.
