Dear Mr. Folliard:

On July 5, 2012, WXON License, Inc. ("Granite"), licensee of television station WMYD(TV), Detroit, Michigan, by its attorneys, filed an Enforcement Complaint against Charter Communications Holding Company, LLC ("Charter") for allegedly dropping station WMYD from its channel lineup on several cable systems serving various communities in Michigan without providing proper notice.

On August 2, 2012, you informed the Commission that the parties have resolved the issue, rendering the Complaint moot. Accordingly, Granite requests that its Complaint be withdrawn with prejudice.

In view of the foregoing, pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's rules, the Complaint is hereby dismissed.
