On January 12, 2012, KVOA Communications, Inc. ("Cordillera"), licensee of television stations KRIS-TV, KRIS-DT2, K68DJ, and K47DF, Corpus Christi, Texas, by its attorneys filed a Retransmission Consent Complaint against Time Warner Cable ("Time Warner"), for refusing to negotiate in good faith for retransmission consent with Cordillera.

On June 22, 2012, you informed the Commission that the parties have now entered into a new agreement resolving the dispute. Accordingly, Cordillera and Time Warner request that the complaint be withdrawn and dismissed.

In view of the foregoing, pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's rules, the Complaint is hereby dismissed.
