
Sweetwater Cable Television Co.'s Request for a Financial Hardship Waiver

On behalf of Sweetwater Cable Television Co. (FRN # 0010338333) serving Sweetwater County, Wyoming ("Sweetwater"), I, Al Carollo Jr, hereby request a streamlined financial hardship waiver of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act rules for one year.

Pursuant to the December 13, 2011, Report and Order in the above-captioned proceeding, I certify that as the 52nd largest cable MVPD, serving two communities with approximately 7,000 combined subscribers in Rock Springs and Green River, Wyoming, Sweetwater: (1) has fewer than 15,000 subscribers and therefore meets the Commission's definition of a small MVPD system; and (2) needs a delay of one year to avoid the financial hardship that would otherwise be imposed if it were required to obtain sooner the necessary upgraded ad insertion equipment and purchase audio monitoring equipment, such Tektronix's Sentry Assure.

I represent and warrant that the above certification is consistent with 47. C.F.R. § 1.17 which requires truthful and accurate statements to the Commission. I also acknowledge that false statements and misrepresentations to the Commission are punishable under Title 18 of the U.S. Code and may subject Sweetwater to enforcement action.
